



FEES & REFUND POLICY

- Fees are due on June 1 for a September start date and December 1 for a February start date.
- Payment plans, if deemed necessary, will be discussed with the Agent and scheduled by the Director.

Withdrawals from the program and refunds:

- Students are able to defer to the next semester or next school year with no financial penalties for any reason.
- Students must give Red Deer Catholic Schools a written notice of withdrawal
- Withdrawal for any reason before the application deadline, students will receive a full refund, less application fee.
- Withdrawal after the application deadline and prior to the start of the program for any reason not related to government travel bans, students will receive a full refund less Application Fee and Homestay Placement Fee.
- If a student's Visa or Study Permit is denied, students will receive a full refund less the Application Fee. Refund requests must include the formal letter of refusal from Canada Immigration.
- Voluntary Withdrawal from the program after the Program Start Date (not compelled by official direction from government, school or homestay program): No refund of tuition after the semester has started. Bus Pass fees may be refunded only for fully unused months. Homestay fees refunds will not be given for partial months and CHN refund policy will be applicable. Medical Insurance and Activity Fees are non refundable.
- No refunds will be granted to a student who is dismissed from the program due to a breach of the law, policy, regulation or student participation agreement as determined by the Government of Canada, the police, and Red Deer Catholic Schools.
- Red Deer Catholic Schools are not liable for losses/expenses that may occur as a result of the district not being able to provide education owing to labour disputes or causes beyond its control.
